

CHIDEOCK ANNUAL VILLAGE MEETING 2019

Minutes of the Chideock Annual Village Meeting held in the Village Hall on Tuesday 21 May 2019 at 7.30 pm.

The meeting was attended by 28 residents, 7 Parish Councillors, the Parish Clerk, Dorset Ward Councillor Simon Christopher.
