Over the last four weeks, a number of residents have raised their concerns about large HGVs and oversize camper vans using Mill Lane to access Golden Cap Holiday Park. The drivers of the HGVs have shared with residents that they do not wish to use Seahill Lane due to a previous occasion when one of the drivers became stuck.</p> <p>Clearly, as a Parish Council we recognise that both Seahill Lane and especially Mill Lane were not intended for HGVs, hence the signage at the turning from the A35 into Duck street which clearly states that the road is not suitable for HGVs. Equally, oversized campervans arriving at Golden Cap Holiday Park need to have some clear guidance from West Dorset Leisure Holidays regarding the most suitable route to enter the site.</p> <p>It would be very helpful if you could consider identifying either an alternative route for the HGVs and large campervans (possibly through Doghouse Lane), or notifying the HGV providers that they need to deliver in smaller vans (as they do at the Anchor).</p> <p>We realise that the site is now becoming very busy, and it would be helpful to have this matter addressed before we move into the six-week holiday period.
