1. Weed out non -Residents
2. Treatment of numbers. So far only those that include their wife or partner or known to have one are included otherwise only the one person writing/email is included.
3. Statistics will be a % of the total number of Residents. Or if we decide to break it down into those only living on the High Street. This also to apply for individual items such as “two way.”
4. Those that are anonymous cannot be counted as we cannot check that they are Residents nor can we judge where they live in Chideock This is a main consideration as some are more badly affected than others.
5. If the spread sheet is to be published then all names to be redacted or deleted for anonymity.
6. As many replies do not give specific yes or no. We have to take that if they do not say yes or no to other specific subjects then we must assume they agree when they do not give an opinion.
7. If answers are an overall no . Do we take it that they disagree with every comment or suggestion or do we give a no only against overall ?
8. Do we reply to all emails or do we put out a notice explaining that what has been said is incorrect and state the correct answer. There were many Residents that do not know that the other Parishes would not support a Bypass or anything else in their Parish .Also many more incorrect statements.
9. Should we consider sending out a survey under the various headings with a simple yes or no. As we were only considering the High Street should we only send it to those who live on the High Street ?
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
